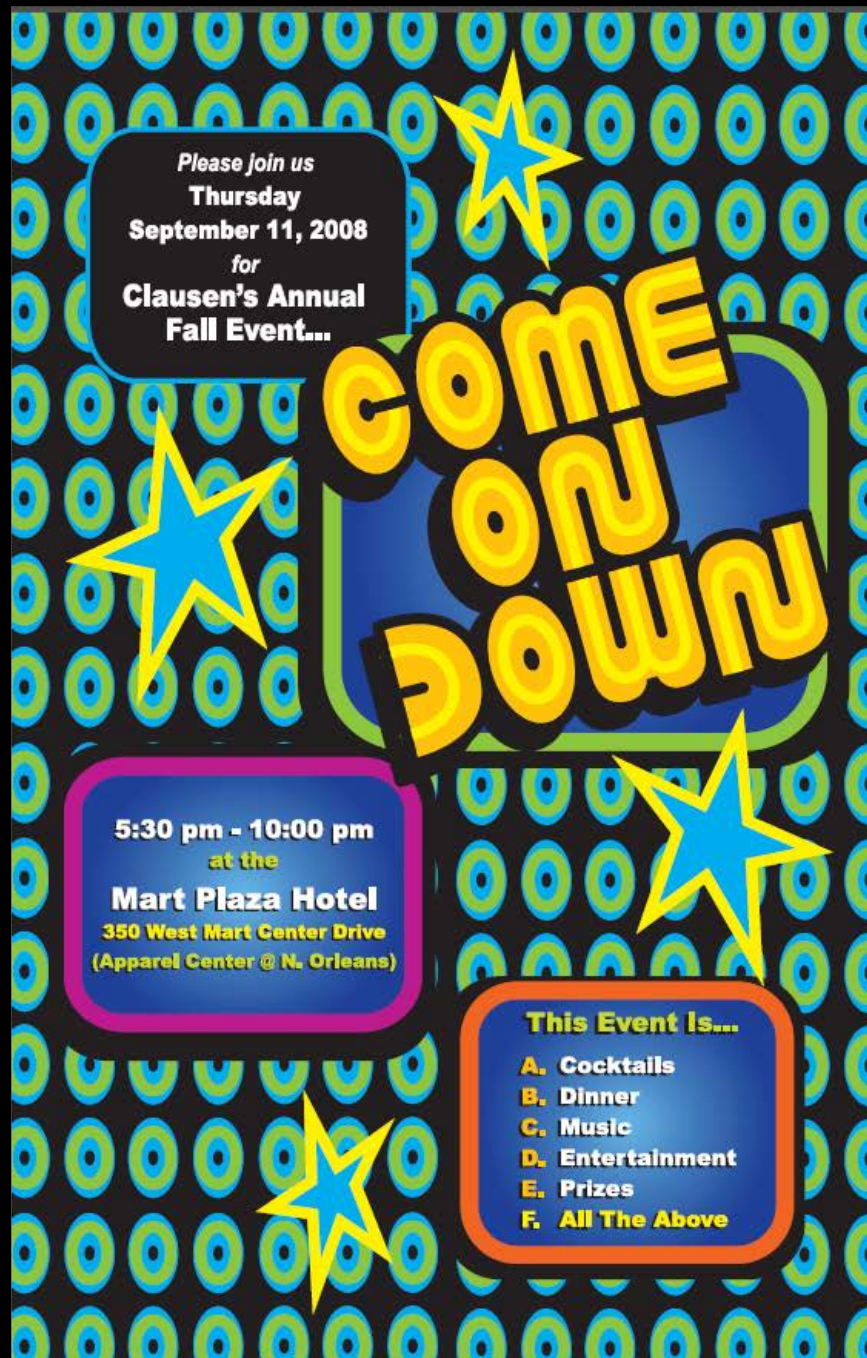

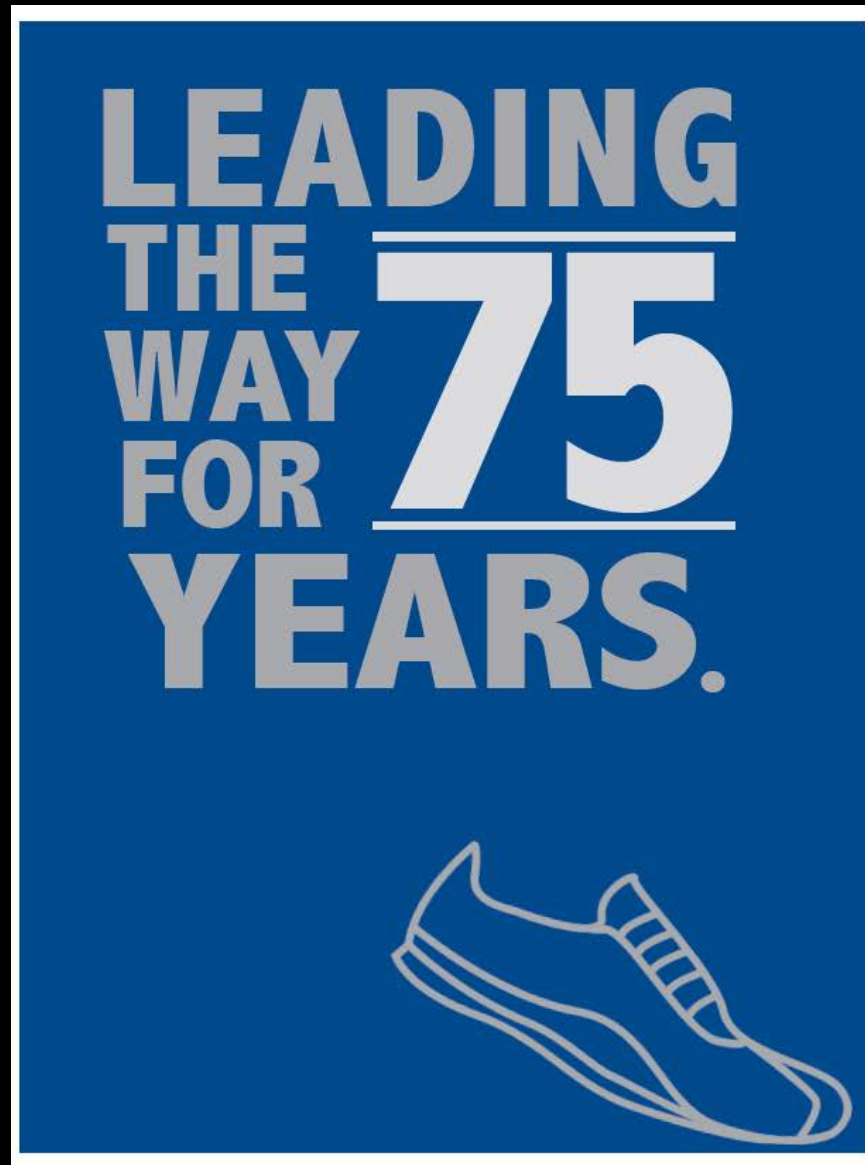

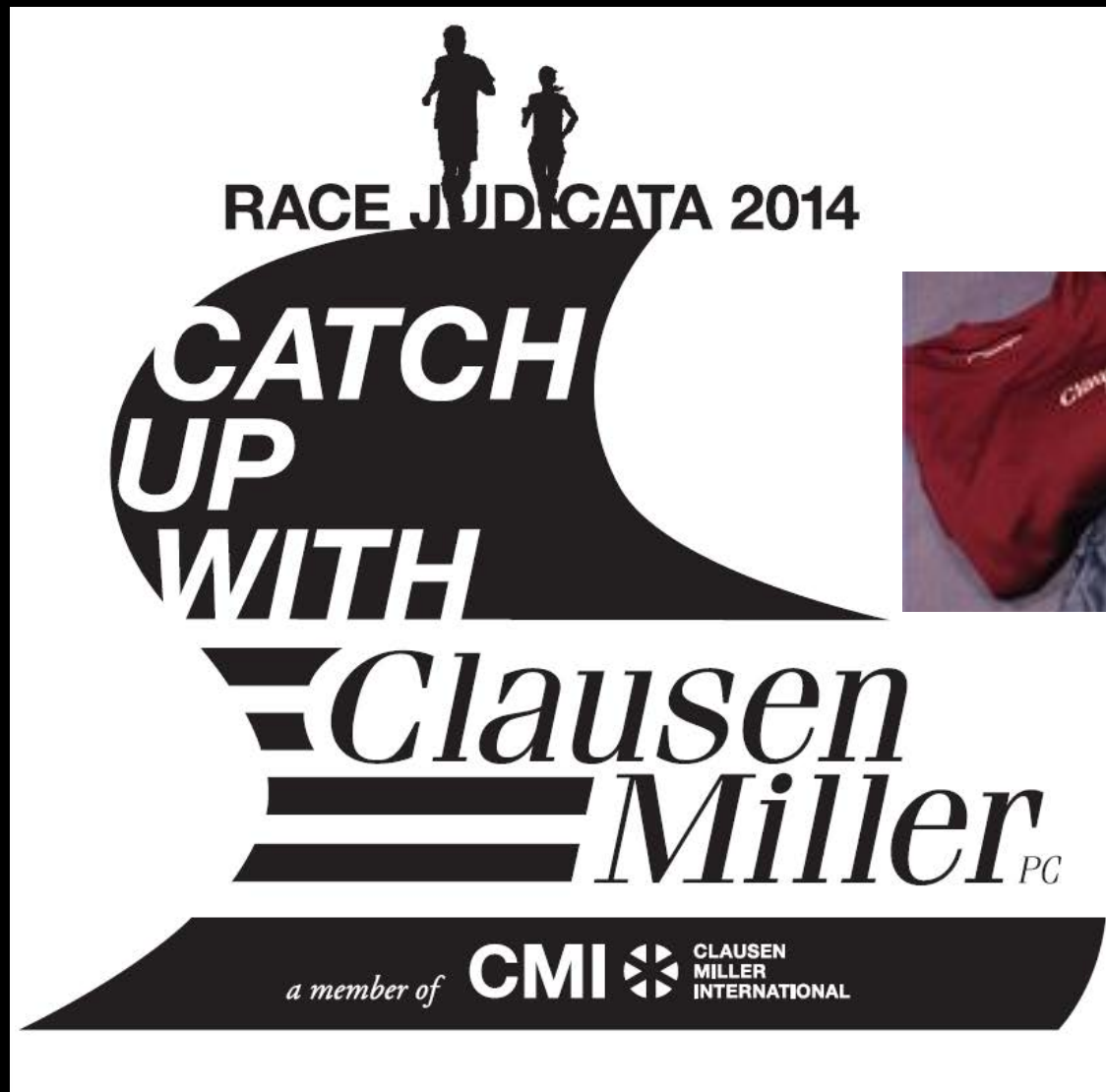

These considerations will be discussed by attorneys experienced in the defense and prosecution of intellectual property claims.

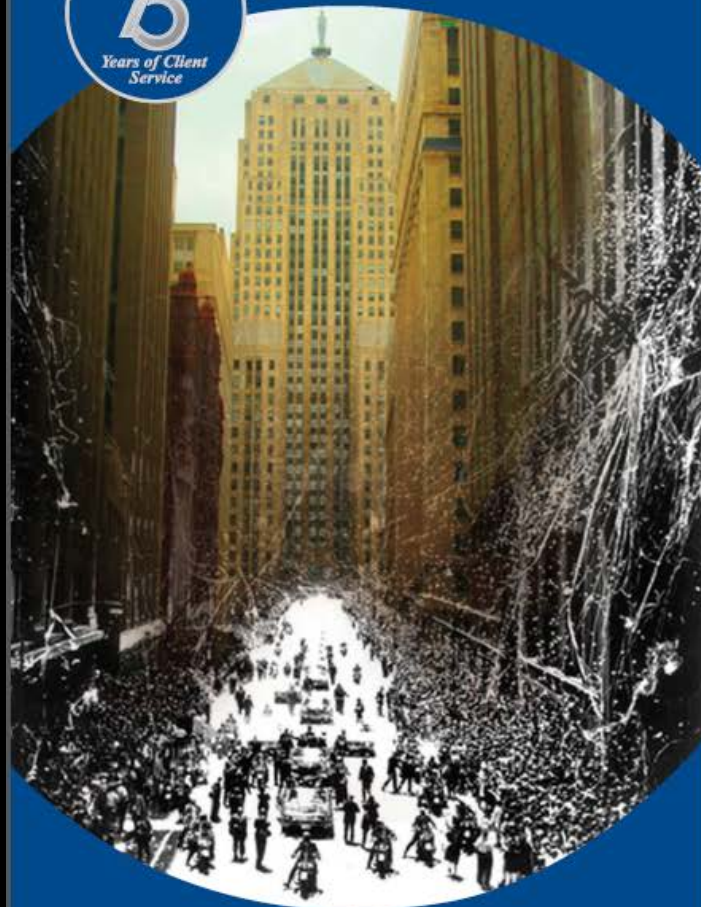

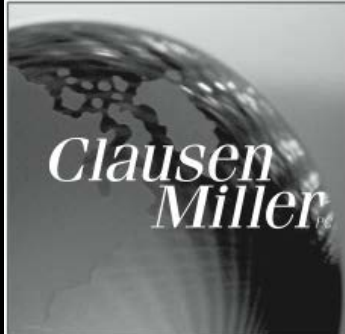

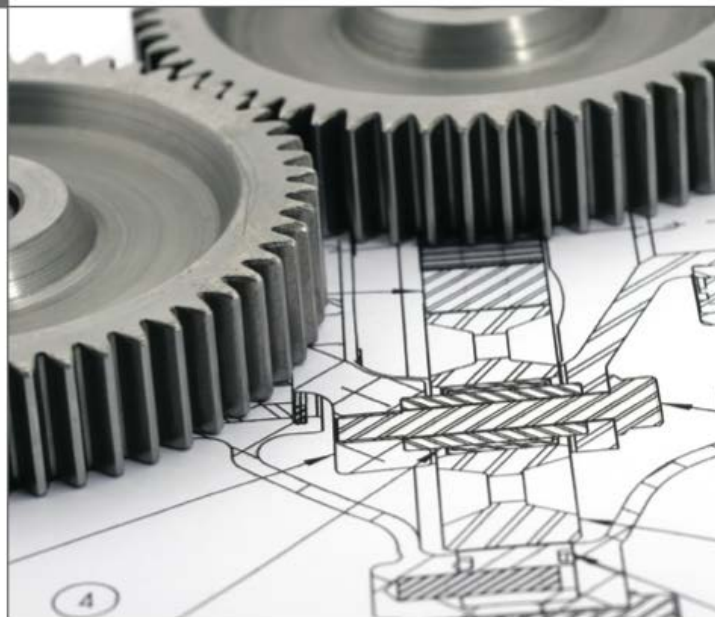

Recruit Holds Punitive Damages Are Not Recoverable for Unseaworthiness

In *McBride v. Erie Well Service, L.L.C.*, ___ F.3d ___, 2014 WL 4783683 (5th Cir. September 25, 2014) (en banc), seamen argued that *Townsend* now makes punitive damages available as a remedy for general maritime law causes of action, including wrongful failure to pay maintenance and cure and unseaworthiness.

McBride held that *Atlantic Seaweed* did not overrule *Miles* and strictly limits the recovery of punitive damages to maintenance and cure claims. In so holding, the Court acknowledged that the issue of recoverability of punitive damages in admiralty is "the subject of national debate with no clear consensus." *McBride* is controlling law only in the Fifth Circuit and it remains to be seen whether other circuits will rule consistently. If not, there is a substantial possibility that the Supreme Court will be called upon once again to further clarify the availability of punitive damages in admiralty.

Sixth Circuit Imposes Defense Obligation On Excess Insurer Based On Denial Of Coverage By Primary Insurer, Potentially Creating Extracontractual Duty To Police And Pursue Primary Insurers

The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals recently issued an opinion with potentially adverse implications for excess insurers, holding that an excess policy with a duty to defend claims for which the underlying insurance "does not provide coverage" must undertake its defense obligations with respect to the insured. See *IMG Worldwide, Inc. v. Westchester Fire Ins. Co.*, 2014 WL 3409044 (6th Cir. July 15, 2014). IMG is particularly troubling since it does not involve exhausted primary coverage or a claim not covered by the primary policy, but rather involves a claim covered by the primary policy that is wrongfully denied.

Facts

In *IMG*, an underlying lawsuit was brought by 270 plaintiffs in November 2008 against IMG and real estate developers ("Sunwest") in Florida state court, seeking over \$300 million in damages for alleged fraud, conversion, civil theft and violations of the Florida Deceptive and Unfair Trade Practices Act ("FDUTPA") relating to the failure of a real estate development project, namely that

undeveloped properties were never upgraded and developed into high-end condominiums as promised (the "*Gastaldi* suit"). IMG had no contractual obligation to develop the condos or the development property, or to finance the project in any way, but was a "consultant" which had licensed to Sunwest the use of the IMG name and logo in marketing materials. Approximately a year after filing the *Gastaldi* suit, the plaintiffs filed an amended complaint that dropped the fraud, conversion and theft claims against IMG, such that only the alleged FDUTPA violations remained.

Great Divide Insurance Company ("Great Divide") provided primary insurance to IMG, with limits of \$1 million, while Westchester Fire Insurance Company ("Westchester") issued an excess policy with limits of \$25 million excess of the Great Divide limits. Both Great Divide and Westchester denied IMG's claim for coverage. IMG ultimately settled the *Gastaldi* case for nearly \$5 million, after having incurred defense costs of over \$8 million. Subsequently,
